- Modernized mini-golf facilities



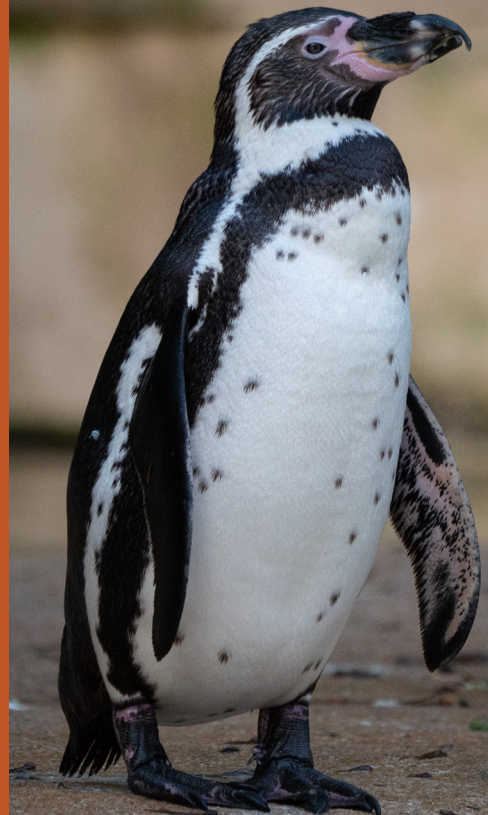
